

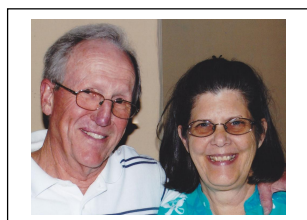
Brevard LITTLE THEATRE SPOTLIGHT

MEET BOARD MEMBERS, JIM & PATRICE ROBINSON

Jim and Patrice Robinson joined the Board in 2011 and immediately accepted the position of Facility Managers. This position entails making sure the theatre is in top condition for performances, events and rentals. Jim has been an active proponent for updating the theatre with fresh paint and devising a way to provide more intimacy to such a large auditorium.

Jim grew up in small-town Richmond, Michigan, spent 3 years in the Army, and then went to Western Michigan University on the GI Bill for Vietnam vets. He was a teacher in the Michigan Upper Peninsula and then a school guidance counselor, coach, and high school play director in Kingston, Michigan. It was here that he met his wife, Patrice.



Patrice was born in Lansing, Michigan, graduated from Michigan State University and taught school for 25 years as a special education teacher.

They worked together for 25 years. During that time they traveled throughout the USA. In the summers, Jim became an avid distance runner, doing five marathons and many shorter road races, qualifying three times for the Boston Marathon.

They retired to Florida where they lived for five years. They stage managed many plays at Venice Little Theatre (now called Venice Theatre). It is one of the top community theatres in the US, employing about 10 people and 600 volunteers.

In 2005 they moved to Brevard and built a new home here that summer. Jim developed a strong interest in photography. He says, "As anyone knows who has been to or lives in this area it's 'eye candy' for a photographer." Patrice and Jim have continued their passion for community theatre at BLT in the technical side by doing lights, sound, and stage managing many plays. Jim is currently directing *The Dixie Swim Club* that is "a great experience made

easier by such a great cast of characters. Not to mention the two wonderful producers of this show, Al Edick and Mary Lou Morrison.” Patrice is the stage manager. She feels “we are heading in a new direction and hopefully this will help build attendance and take us into the next decade”.

Jim and Patrice are the parents of three children and grandparents of six. His interests in retirement continue to be traveling both the US and Europe, photography, hiking, working out and bluegrass music. Patrice enjoys traveling, crocheting, sewing and gardening.
